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## WEEKLY USA GRAIN AND PROTEIN REPORT August 30, 2025

Monday is a holiday in the US – Labor Day -- and all markets and offices will be closed for the day.

Corn prices in the US were up by about USD 4 m/t this week with soybeans up by at most a dollar or two and soymeal down by USD 2 or so a m/t. Soft red winter wheat was up by about USD 3 m/t while hard red winter wheat was unchanged at the end of the week. US spring wheat was down by about USD 4 m/t.

Corn prices were up a little due to a lack of rainfall in some areas. While soybeans suffered from high world soybean stocks and a lack of any China business. There was no new trend seen in wheat prices this week.

Much of the market activity at the end of the week was due to the holiday on Monday with most traders covering their positions. The corn futures market saw short sellers covering shorts before the weekend and corn futures were the most traded grain/oilseed this week.

Looking at the month's performance on futures prices, soybeans were up by 6.6% for the month with soymeal up by 4.7% and corn up by 1.6%. All USA wheat prices were down for the month.

## SECTION 2 --- FISHMEAL COMMENTS AND PRICES: PERUVIAN “INDICATION” FISHMEAL PRICES:

No catch reported for the South Region this week --- weather was very bad with ports closed. No catch now for about three weeks.

Estimated fishmeal sales up to 580,000 m/t with remaining supply said to be less than 10,000 m/t.

Trade reports say that there is some early business surfacing for the next fishing season. The feeling in the trade seems to be that prices will have to soften a bit as demand from China could be lower due to large stocks on hand and enroute for China.

At least one trade report is showing new season prime price indication at USD 1700 CNF China. Comments from China are that new season price indications from Peru are too high for market conditions.

MSI Ceres published corrected Peru export numbers for January to June 2025 ---- total fishmeal exports are at 764,000 m/t with China taking 629,200 m/t (82.4%)
